Host Church Guidelines

- Church must provide housing for youth and adults attending camp, Thursday evening through Sunday morning. Each camp will worship with their host church on Sunday morning.
- There will not be another group scheduled to stay at the host church during the time that BIG HOUSE is scheduled to occupy your church.
- You may not attend the camp that your church is hosting; you are encouraged to attend camp at a different location.
- Host church must provide a kitchen to be used during the duration of the camp, to cook breakfast, and dinner each day.
- Host church must provide a general meeting area for use in the mornings (before departure from base camp) and in the evenings (after showers and evening activities) for various programs and announcements.
- Host church contact must be available to help secure various necessities such as shower facilities, (usually a Jr. High or High school) locating area hospitals, making contact with churches in your area in need of work (does not need to be United Methodist) and give guidance on evening activities, such as swimming, going to state park, etc.
- Host church contact person should be available during the duration of the camp in case of emergencies or of any questions the Director might have to help make the camp successful.
- We always appreciate donations of meals, snacks, etc.
- If any damages occur during a BIG HOUSE camp, please notify the Director immediately so that we can rectify the situation.
